PFC PROGRAMS & EVENTS	DESCRIPTIONS OF PFC PROGRAMS & EVENTS
Breakfast Book Club (monthly before school)	Occurring one morning a month, interested students come together to read and discuss pre-chosen books. Participants receive breakfast and the book for that month. Participant cost covers the cost of the book that they will keep. Need 6 volunteers to lead book discussion, 6 to help serve breakfast and escort kids to class.
Run Club (every Thursday before school) (NO RUNNING REQUIRED)	Every Thursday morning, students can join parents and teachers to burn off some energy before class begins. Role of coordinator is to recruit runners by sharing flyers for the club, collect waivers from parents for each runner, show up each week at Run Club to count laps and record lap data, give out prizes for laps run monthly, and organize a party at the end of the year.
Room Parent for each classroom	Keep class parents informed of school happenings, coordinate classroom parties and teacher appreciation
Junior Achievement (JA)	Parent volunteers teach a few lessons in the classroom throughout the school year. Lessons cover entrepreneurship, work readiness, and financial literacy through hands-on, experiential activities.
Art Volunteer/Docent	Parent volunteers teach art lessons and then collect all the artwork.
Spring Fundraiser	Otis Spunkmeyer Kick Off Assembly Otis Spunkmeyer Sales & rewards handed out at gates Otis Spunkmeyer Delivery & Distribution Day
Scandia Family Science Night	Students and parents work together to conduct simple inquiry-based science activities. All materials and instructions provided by Sandia.
Kolb Trunk or Treat	Parent volunteers decorate their vehicles and hand out treats to the kids that stop by to trick-or-treat. At least 30 vehicles are needed, and candy is donated by parents.
Movie Night	The Kolb Community gathers together to watch a family-friendly movie in Kolb's MPR
Open House/Art Fair	Occurring along with Kolb's Spring Open House, the Art Fair highlights pieces created by every student at Kolb through the Art in Action program
Science Fair	Interested Kolb students use the scientific method to plan and conduct independent research and present their findings to the Kolb Community at an evening event.

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Donuts with Dad	Organized by moms so Kolb students can celebrate their father-figures with breakfast treats at this morning event.
Muffins with Mom	Organized by dads so Kolb students can celebrate their mother-figures with breakfast treats at this morning event.
Vision Screening DK, K, Grade 2, and Grade 5	Volunteers needed to assist student with vision screening
Hearing Van DK, K, Grade 2, and Grade 5	Volunteers needed to assist student with hearing testing
Character Assemblies (monthly on Friday)	Need 3-6 volunteers every month. It does not need to be the same volunteers each month.
Student Store (every Friday during morning recess)	Students earn Blue Tickets during the school day by showing positive Character Traits. They then can spend their Blue Tickets at the Student Store on Fridays during recess. Need at least 2 parent volunteers every Friday. It does not need to be the same volunteers each week.
Picture Day	Volunteers needed to assist student with picture day
Picture Retake Day	Volunteers needed to assist student with picture retake day
Spring School Pictures	Volunteers needed to assist student with picture day
Red Ribbon Week	Red Ribbon Pledges/Banner Signing during lunch
Winter Concert	In coordination with Kolb's Music Teacher, the 4th/5th Grade Choir, with the 3rd Graders on recorder, perform for the Kolb Community at this December evening event.
